



**Regional Facilitators (2)**  
**Arable Extension (Part-time; Fixed-term - ending September 2023)**

**FAR is developing an arable industry extension framework called Growers Leading Change (GLC) which revolves around a small team of part-time extension group facilitators.**

The role of the facilitators is to form, lead and support local and national discussion groups focusing on environmental, agronomic or farm business issues and opportunities for the arable industry. Facilitators help groups develop extension plans and assist with identifying, developing, and delivering a range of resources and activities to meet growers' learning needs and encourage on-farm change.

There are currently two part-time, fixed-term positions available. One in the lower North Island and one in Canterbury. The successful candidates will work from home, using their own vehicle (mileage reimbursed). Other work-related materials, including laptops and phones, will be supplied. Training will be provided.

Successful candidates will have a relevant tertiary qualification or equivalent experience and sound knowledge of arable farming systems. In addition, they should have proven skills in:

- Organising and facilitating focused events and activities.
- Speaking with authority and writing clearly and effectively for a farmer audience.
- Meeting operational targets on time and within budget.
- Working with a range of stakeholders and pan-sector / industry partners.
